## Do you B.A.R.K.?

Herget is a PBIS school! PBIS stands for Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports. This is a proactive, school-wide approach to behavior management. Through this program students are specifically taught behavioral expectations and are rewarded for demonstrating appropriate school behavior.

At Herget we teach the Husky B.A.R.K. which stands for Be Ready, Acept Responsibility, Respect Yourself, Others, and Environment, and Kee Your Hands and Feet to Yourself. Take some time to talk with your student about the Husky B.A.R.K. and encourage him or her to demonstrate appropriate behavior.

## Parking at Herget

During the school day, please only park in marked parking spaces. Cars should not be parked in red fire lanes at any time for any reason. If you are dropping off or picking up your student, please do not stop or park in the red fire lanes. Before and after school, please do not drive down the bus lane while busses or students are present.

For after school events, parents are welcome to park in any parking spaces (including those marked reserved) and may also park in the lanes in front of school as long as the curb is not painted red.

## Contact Information and Student Pick Up.

It is very important that you update your student's contact information with the office if there are changes. It is essential that the school is able to contact you in case of an emergency. Only the parent/guardian may update the information, and this must be done in person or in writing. Individuals listed as a contact for your student may have contact with the student and may pick up the student from school. All people listed as contacts, including the parents or guardians, must show a valid photo ID in order to have contact with the student. Anyone not listed as a contact or not having a photo ID will not be able to have contact with the student.

## Simple Ways to Stay Healthy From the Kane County Health Department (kanehealth.com)

1. Keep your hands clean by washing them with soap and warm water.
2. Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when coughing or sneezing.
3. Avoid touching your eyes, nose, or mouth and spreading germs to them.
